

DRIVER EDUCATION

The District may provide elective driver education training for eligible students and charge a fee for such courses, provided that the fee does not exceed the actual cost of providing the course, minus any State reimbursements received. The purpose of this comprehensive program is to provide students an opportunity to participate in a State-approved driver education training course which gives the student an excellent beginning in becoming a responsible driver.

Under Ohio law, a student may elect to enroll in a commercial school for driver education training. A letter of authorization shall be granted a student to enroll in a commercial school, provided that:

1. approval is secured from the principal prior to enrollment in a commercial school; and,
2. the student is at least 15 years, 6 months of age.

Pupils completing driver training courses provided wholly or in part by commercial driver training schools shall not be granted credit.
