

Interdistrict Open Enrollment (outside district)

Students from other Ohio school districts may enroll in any Cleveland Municipal School District school subject to the criteria established by law, this policy, and rules of the Chief Executive Officer. A student shall be excluded if the student has been suspended or expelled for ten or more consecutive days in the academic term for which admission is sought or in the immediately preceding term. Students admitted under this Interdistrict Enrollment Policy shall not be charged tuition or any other fee not charged to students who are residents of the District.

Applications for Interdistrict Enrollment must be submitted to the Student Assignment Office within 10 days of the beginning of the new school year. Assignment and approval for Open Enrollment will be given through the first week of October of any given school year.

The procedures for admitting students under the Interdistrict Enrollment Policy, including the establishment of class and building capacity limits, shall be the same as used under the Intradistrict Policy except that resident pupils shall have first priority for admission to schools. Applicants previously enrolled under the Interdistrict Policy shall have priority over first-time applicants. Procedures to ensure that an appropriate racial balance is maintained in the district schools shall be the same as used in the Intradistrict Policy.
