

COMMUNITY USE OF DISTRICT FACILITIES

The use of buildings and grounds for special non-District activities shall be governed by the following principles:

1. The use of facilities for non-District activities shall be by permit only;
2. the use of facilities for large functions (i.e., dances, concerts, festivals) where large attendance is anticipated shall be approved by the Board;
3. permits for large functions shall not be granted unless suitable and convenient off-street parking is available;
4. the facilities shall be suitable for the purpose;
5. the use of the facilities shall not disrupt regular operations;
6. the use of the facilities shall be subject to a reasonable fee according to a fee schedule which reflects actual costs to the district for janitorial, light and heat expenses as well as other costs;
7. schedules of activities shall be established and maintained so that possible conflict between non-district and district sponsored programs shall be eliminated;
8. any group using District school facilities may be required to present satisfactory evidence that it possesses liability and/or property damage insurance;
9. all District school buildings are smoke-free. Citizens entering school buildings will be expected to adhere to the District's smoke-free policy;
10. policies and rules applicable to any persons entering upon school grounds or premises shall be posted conspicuously at or near all entrances to the school grounds, premises, and/or buildings.
